

Rock Music Quiz #3: Easy Old School Rock

Instructions:

One person acts as the Game Master. First you need to print out page 5 and page 6 of this document and provide one copy of the pages, which contains the sheet to fill in the answers to the quiz, for each participating person or team. You will also need pencils and a source to play music from Spotify, like a speaker with Bluetooth.

After that, you, the Game Master will read out the questions below out loud. You will then play the corresponding song to the question that you find in the provided playlist, which you find below in this document or on the website. The participants of the game will fill in the answer to that question on their answer sheet. Each question has four sub-questions, marked as A, B, C and D. For A, you fill in the name of the band or artist. For B, you fill in the name of the song. For C, you fill in the name of the album and for D, you fill in the answer to a trivia question about either the song or the artist/band.

You decide yourself how many of A, B, C and D you will include in your quiz, as well as how many points each sub-question is worth. Note that for a few songs, they had no album, as they were released as singles, and I wanted to include them anyway, sort of as trick questions. For that you simply fill in Single. The trivia questions was the last thing I added, after I already picked the songs and artists, but I tried to give some variation for the type of questions. Also note that most of the trivia questions are really hard

and that the information is taken from Wikipedia and various other sources on the internet and in some cases, it COULD be somewhat outdated or incorrect but for most questions it should be correct.

Example how to play: You read Question 1: "Fill in the name of this band at A, the name of the song at B, the name of the album at C and fill in what country they are from at D (as an example of a trivia question)". You then play the song related to the question. Let's say "Song 1: Queen - Bohemian Rhapsody with trivia question: Who played this band's singer in the movie with the same name as the song, that came out in 2018?". Then the participants fill in Queen at A, Bohemian Rhapsody at B, A Night at the Opera at C and Rami Malek (who played Freddie in the movie) at D in the sheet for Question 1. Rinse and repeat for all 15 questions.

After all 15 questions are done, the participants hand in their sheet and you compare it to the correct answers and whoever has the most correct answers is obviously the winner. At a tie, it's up to you to decide what to do as a tie breaker!
